

## **Visual Approach Notes**

- 1. ROTIP / LONIK visual approaches will only be authorized by ATC subject to traffic. ATC phraseology will be CLEARED ROTIP / LONIK VISUAL APPROACH RUNWAY 31.
- 2. ROTIP / LONIK visual approaches are normally available for LMML arrivals entering the TMA via entry points DIRKA, EKOLA, UPLIT, MOLAM and DORAT.
- 3. When cleared by ATC to conduct a visual approach, pilots are required to follow the entire procedure from ROTIP - KEGON - ENELO - ML361 or LONIK - DEMIX - ENELO - ML361.
- 4. ROTIP / LONIK visual approaches require RNAV 5/FMS navigation capability and are designed to enable a Continuous Descent Approach. Descent below 3000ft is only authorized after passing KEGON / DEMIX.
- 5. ROTIP / LONIK visual approaches will not be approved by ATC when the ceiling is less than 2000ft or the visibility is less than 5km.
- 6. VFR aircraft activity may be present at 2000ft or below in the vicinity of ROTIP over Marsascala Bay (MB).
